The system also enables you to minimise risks associated with over-prescribing; inbuilt warnings actively pop up to remind staff if a similar type of medication has already been prescribed, for instance in the case of a patient who receives regular paracetamolbased prescriptions and is prescribed additional paracetamol 'as needed'.

Support for mental and paediatric health

Mental health providers can rest assured that their needs are catered for within Carenotes ePMA. You can configure the module to fit your own requirements, enabling you to set a dosage maximum, which would then generate warnings if the limit is reached. Additional features for paediatric dosing can also be configured within the system, enabling providers of CAMHS and child health to receive the same system benefits.


