LAND REGISTRY – WITHDRAWN FORM

The Land Registration (Amendment) Rules 2018 came into force on 6 April 2018. The amendment rules revoked rule 204 of the Land Registration Rules 2003 which allowed people to request the return of certain documents in certain situations. As a result LRRD1 can no longer be used and is now withdrawn to prevent accidental use.
